Simulator Training – All simulator training listed above is pilot flying time. Pilot not flying time is available if training as a crew or if paired with another client. If a FlightSafety Instructor is used as a second crew member, an additional fee will be charged.

ATP Check - If Course includes 100% Simulator Check for ATP, an additional day must be added for the ATP Oral and Flight Check. Please contact the Learning Center for the cost of the ATP checkride.
