Course Length – Does not include a simulator check day. A simulator check day is required for FAA Initial and Prior Experience courses and may be required for a Recurrent course. A simulator check day will be given for Non – FAA courses when requested.

Simulator Training – All simulator training listed above is pilot flying time. Pilot not flying time is available if training as a crew or if paired with another client. If a FlightSafety Instructor is used as a second crew member, an additional fee will be charged.

Type Rating Prerequisites – as a minimum, the pilot must possess a multi engine and instrument rating with 1000 hours total time for the SAAB 340 Type Rating.

Prior Experience Course – This course is designed for pilots who are currently flying the aircraft (Single Pilot or Crew) and who are seeking an FAA type rating, or an FAA ATP with a type rating. These pilots must have completed an FAA approved initial course prior to enrollment and meet the FAA type rating and/or FAA ATP prerequisites.

ATP Prerequisites – FlightSafety is able to administer Airline Transport Certificate (ATP) Checks during the Pilot Initial and Prior Experience Course. To qualify, pilots must meet the requirements of 14 CFR Part 61.155 through 61.159.

Second Crewmember Rate- Pilot training that requires FlightSafety to provide a second crewmember will be charged an additional hourly rate per simulator hour. Please contact the Learning Center for details.

Training Materials – Training and Pre-Course Study materials are available electronically to clients 60 days prior to scheduled training via FlightBag, our second-generation training materials app. Materials are updated automatically as new information becomes available, yet keeps all of your previous notes. The FlightBag App is available on iTunes for free.

Maintenance Training – Maintenance Training is also available for this aircraft.
