Course Description – 4.0 Hour Course

General Emergency Training Recurrent provides corporate flight crewmembers with knowledge and procedures for handling emergency situations. The course is a review of the pre-flight and use of emergency equipment such as window and door exits, fire extinguishers, oxygen equipment, life vests, and life rafts.

This course fulfills the IS-BAO/ICAO recommendation for emergency familiarization every 12 months. The General Emergency Initial fulfills the FAA requirement and IS-BAO/ICAO recommendations for emergency familiarization with drills training every 24 months.

This course can be taught at our Learning Centers or onsite at your facility.
