# Falcon Advanced Rejected Takeoff Go/No-Go

*Course Information*

During this four-hour simulator session, each crew member will face up to 18 different scenarios, requiring a decision by the flight crew to either continue the takeoff or abort. In addition to gaining proficiency in the go/no-go decision-making process, this invaluable course also gives pilots an opportunity to fly their aircraft under the high stress and demands of an emergency return to the airport in the case of an extreme emergency after takeoff. Most pilots have never operated their aircraft with the level of aggressiveness and precision required to get back to the airport quickly under an extreme emergency condition. Each pilot will have the opportunity to practice multiple emergency return scenarios to proficiency. Update your go/no-go decision process with FlightSafety – your trusted training leader. Make sure your crews are ready to respond quickly and correctly when the unexpected strikes.
