Course Description – 10 Day Course

Each technician, working on the GFS and Maintenance Trainer, sharpens troubleshooting skills and refines decision-making abilities in a comfortable learning environment. During the exercises the instructor monitors each person’s diagnostic and troubleshooting procedures offering guidance to help them achieve the highest level of proficiency. An instructor review focuses on the logic used by each individual to decide on their plan of action. Test equipment and the functional training on the S-70 Maintenance Trainer allows each technician to work providing actual “hands-on” during the troubleshooting process.
