**Initial Curriculum** – This training will prepare a pilot to safely and efficiently operate the aircraft and perform duties and responsibilities associated with a multi-crew cockpit operation. An optional simulator check-ride is available upon request. FlightSafety does not provide in-flight training.

**Recurrent Course** – Recurrent course provides pilots with the necessary training to become familiar with all of the information concerning major components and systems, performance and limitations, standard and emergency procedures, and the contents of the approved flight manual. Crew Resource Management is included as part of the flight training process. An optional simulator check-ride is available upon request. FlightSafety does not provide in-flight training.

**Second Crewmember Rate** – If FlightSafety is required to supply a FlightSafety Instructor as second crewmember, an additional hourly rate per simulator hour will apply.
