Prior Experience Course – This course is designed for pilots who are seeking an additional type rating (Single Pilot or Crew), or the addition of an ATP. Also, this course is for those pilots who have been flying the aircraft as SIC and now want to obtain a Type Rating. **All Prior Experience Courses are scheduled on request.**

Partner Pricing – Allows 2 or more pilots to train at a reduced price if they are training under the same account number.

ATP Check Ride – Available during Initial Training upon request for an additional fee.

ATP Prerequisites – FlightSafety is able to administer Airline Transport Pilot Certificate (ATP) Checks during the Pilot Initial and Prior Experience Course. To qualify, pilots must meet the requirements of 14 CFR Part 61.155 through 61.159.

Training Materials – Training and Pre-Course Study materials are available electronically to clients 60 days prior to scheduled training via FlightBag. Materials are updated automatically as new information becomes available, yet keeps all of your previous notes
