Simulator Training- Simulator hours are based on crew training.

Course Length - Course length does not include simulator check days, if required.

Differences Training - Differences training is not conducted on a standalone basis and must be taken in conjunction with either a G450 or G550 Initial or Recurrent (as outlined below). These courses will be scheduled, immediately after the completion of the related aircraft specific recurrent training, during the same training period.

Transition Training – Pilots transitioning from the GV to the G550 must take an avionics transition course prior to G550 Recurrent.
