Indoctrination Course – FlightSafety has designed a 2-day Indoctrination Course for pilots who possess a CE525 type rating, have no Garmin G3000 experience, and are transitioning to the M2. This course is conducted two days prior to the start of the standard M2 Recurrent or Prior Experience Course, on select days.

Additional Check Rides – Initial, Prior Experience, and Recurrent Courses include one check ride. If more than one check ride is required, an additional charge may be incurred.

Prior Experience Course – This course is designed for pilots who are seeking an additional type rating (Single Pilot or Crew), or the addition of an ATP. Also, this course is for those pilots who have been flying the aircraft as SIC and now want to obtain a Type Rating. **All Prior Experience Courses are scheduled upon request.**

Type Rating Prerequisites – As a minimum, pilot must possess a multi-engine and instrument rating for the CE525 Type Rating.

ATP Prerequisites – FlightSafety is able to administer Airline Transport Certificate (ATP) Checks during the Initial and Prior Experience Courses. To qualify, pilots must meet the requirements of 14CFR Part 61.155 through 61.159.

EASA Transition for Citation 525 Series: Mandatory for EASA Clients transitioning Single Pilot (SP) to Multi Pilot (MP) or Multi Pilot to Single Pilot. Please refer to CJ 525 Series EASA Transition Fact Sheet.
