Prior Experience Course – This course is designed for pilots who are seeking the addition of an ATP or have previous limited experience in the aircraft. **All Prior Experience Courses are scheduled upon request.**

ATP Prerequisites – FlightSafety is able to administer Airline Transport Pilot Certificate (ATP) Checks during the Pilot Initial and Prior Experience Course. To qualify, pilots must meet the requirements of 14 CFR Part 61.155 through 61.159.

ProLine 21 Course - The ProLine 21 course must be completed prior to starting in the Recurrent course unless the pilot was previously qualified in the ProLine 21 Avionics and FMS 3000.

Training Materials – Training and Pre-Course Study materials are available electronically to clients 60 days prior to scheduled training via FlightBag. Materials are updated automatically as new information becomes available, yet keeps all of your previous notes.

EASA Transition for King Air C90GTi: Mandatory for EASA Clients transitioning Single Pilot (SP) to Multi Pilot (MP) or Multi Pilot to Single Pilot. Please refer to King Air EASA Transition Fact Sheet.
