Gulfstream G550 Series Recurrent Advanced Troubleshooting

Course Information

Course Description – 4 Day Course

FlightSafety's Gulfstream G550 Series Advanced Troubleshooter System (ATS) is a classroom application that allows the maintenance technician the ability to troubleshoot aircraft down to the component level.

Technicians will view system malfunctions in a real-time cockpit environment based on real-world scenarios. Each troubleshooting scenario immerses the technician into the simulation with all the cockpit indications, diagnostic tools (CMC / MDC) and maintenance publications that would normally be available if the technician was troubleshooting the actual aircraft.

The ATS program also incorporates FlightSafety's "Four Step Process" philosophy of troubleshooting which provides a logical step by step approach and is the core to every troubleshooting scenario

Note: This recurrent course should not be attended unless the technician has previously completed the original G550 Advanced Troubleshooter, as the design of this course assumes the student has the prerequisite knowledge and skills obtained through attendance of the original course.
